

## LTC Regular Meeting Minutes November 2, 2024

Call to order at 10:03 AM. Tracy LaRosa, Louisa Stephen, and Michael LaRosa were present.

Minutes from the January 7, 2023 (ML1, LS2), February 4, 2023 (ML1, LS2), September 7, 2024 (ML1, LS2), and October 5, 2024 (ML1, LS2) were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Checking \$3,791.92 and Savings \$1,702.48. Total: \$5,494.40.

No one is swimming in the lakes due to colder weather which is good with continued dangerous algae growth.

Deputy Dennis Miller reported that there were no Part 1 crimes in the Lakes area for the month of October.

Staff from LA County Public Works, Josie Gutierrez and Roger Aliaga discussed road maintenance projects in the area. Residents at the meeting report there is still significant flooding on Lake Hughes Road near Devere Court. Ms. Gutierrez stated that if any residents have specific problems with flooding on roads to call her at 661-947-7173.

Patricia Wood, P.E. Senior Civil Engineer with LACPW Stormwater Engineering Division gave a presentation on flood risk in the area and how to prepare in case of a flood.
