

Regular Lakes Town Council Meeting Minutes October 5, 2024

Call to order at 10:06 AM.

Roll: Tracy LaRosa, Louisa Stephen, and Michael LaRosa.

The September Minutes were tabled and the July Minutes were approved (ML1;LS2).

The President's Report indicated that Tracy attended the ARTC meeting via Zoom.

The dumping of contaminated mulch is a serious fire hazard. There will not be a three-way stop installed at the corner of Elizabeth Lake Road and San Francisquito Canyon Road.

Chuck Bostwick reported that there was a mulch fire in San Bernardino County that burned for several months. Supervisor Barger has moved that efforts be made to combat the same from occurring in this district. The amount of acceptable trash in mulch is 0.05 percent by weight. The Department of Public Health has observed the fires.

Deputy Dennis Miller reported September crimes as one burglary; one vehicle petty theft; and one assault in Lake Hughes. There has been a spike in thefts in Green Valley and the Lakes. Residents are advised to lock homes and cars.

Josie Gutierrez of Public Works indicated that the paving of Elizabeth Lake Road

between Lake Hughes Road and Munz Ranch Road has been delayed due to funding concerns.

Hugo Acevedo of Building and Safety explained that there will be some exemptions regarding the new earthquake fault zone maps for new construction. For example, if the cost of completing studies is less than or equal to the value of the house. Additions and new structures are not exempt. Manufactured houses are considered to be new structures.
